

JOINT GAD-TWG AND MOVE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. 19-01

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE 2019 ACTIVITIES FOR THE
18 DAY CAMPAIGN TO END VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN (VAW) IN PVAO**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Commission on Women, the government agency mandated to usher gender equality and women empowerment, released the 2019 Calendar of Activities for the 18 Day Campaign to End VAW last September 26, 2019.

WHEREAS, government agencies may align their respective End VAW activities to the said 2019 PCW calendar and/or adopt their own line up of activities in accordance with their approved GAD Plan and Budget (GPB) for CY2019.

WHEREAS, Item 24 of PVAO's GPB 2019 provides for "1. Conduct/ Participation on the 18 Day Campaign to End VAW and 2. Setting up of GAD Exhibits and others during the 18 Day Campaign to End VAW" with a budget allocation of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P250,000.00)

WHEREAS, the PVAO Education and Training (PET) Plan 2019 also provides for the conduct of GAD related seminars/ trainings which can be conducted within the 18 Day Campaign to End VAW period.


WHEREAS, the GAD-TWG and the Men Opposed to Violence Everywhere (MOVE) Committee held a series of meetings as documented through the attached minutes of meetings to finalize the 2019 End VAW activities in PVAO.


WHEREAS, the attached final list of activities entail Eighty One Thousand Pesos (P81,000.00) or only 32% of the approved P250,000.000 budget for End VAW activities, inclusive of the recent MOVE DND directions to participate in the "Kilos, Lakad" fun walk activity.


RESOLVED finally, that this Resolution be forwarded to the Administrator, Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) for approval.






